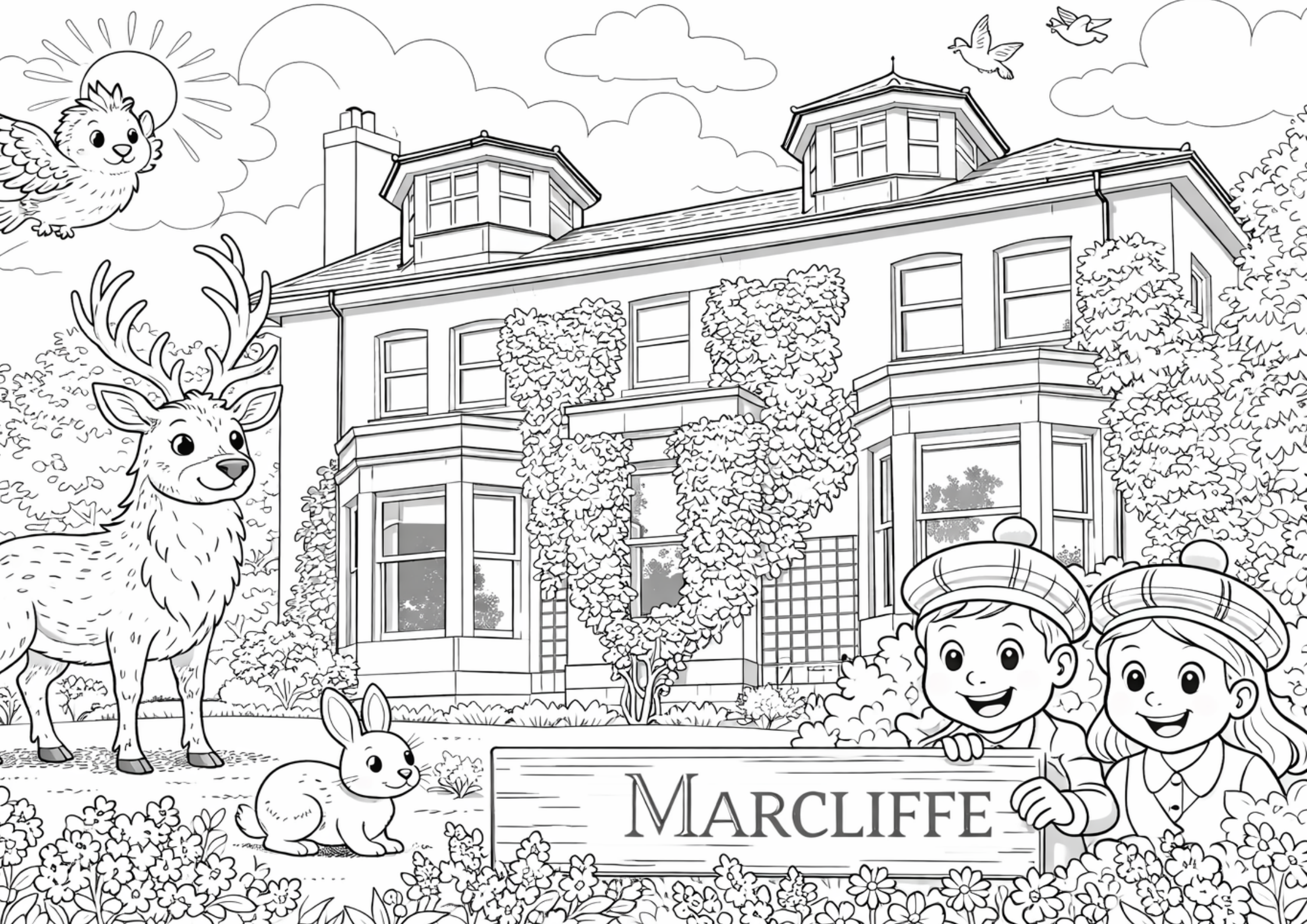

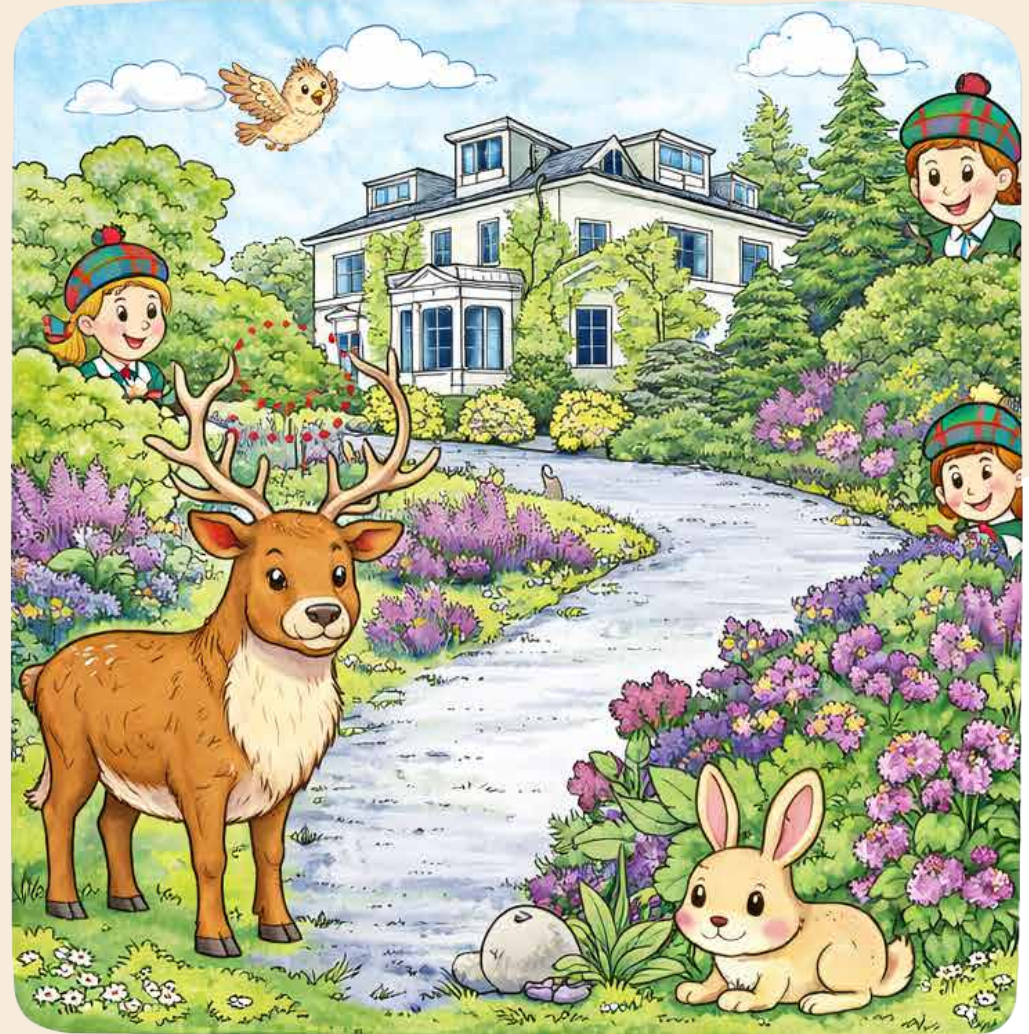
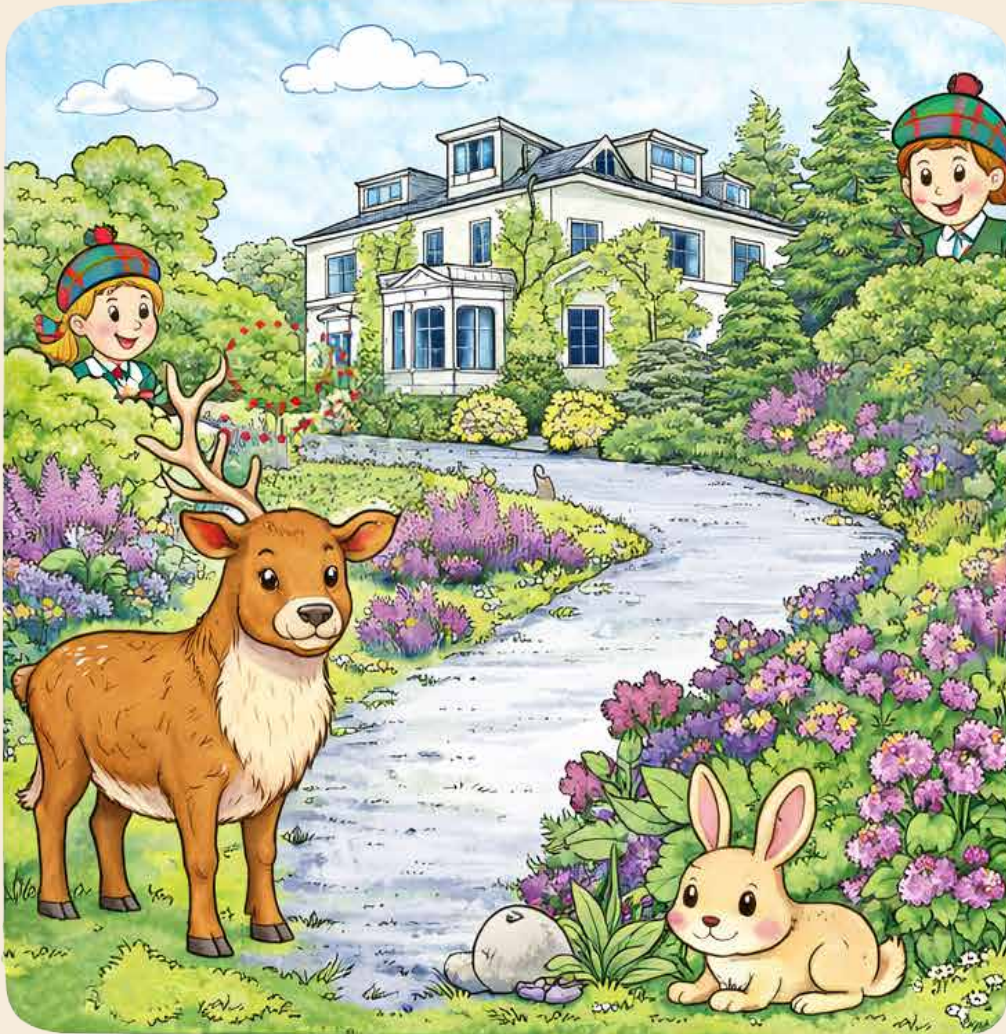

What's your favourite Scottish food or treat?

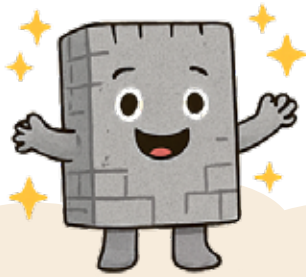
Why do some castle staircases turn clockwise?

Here are some fun facts to learn about Aberdeen... and some brilliant things to discuss at your table.



Aberdeen is called The Granite City because lots of its buildings are made from shiny grey granite that sparkles in the sun

Aberdeen has two rivers, the Dee and the Don. They gave the city its name! "Aber" meaning river mouth in Gaelic.

People have lived here for around 8,000 years, since Stone Age hunter-gatherers!



Aberdeen is home to one of the longest running newspapers in the world, The Press and Journal, founded in 1747

Aberdeen Football Club's stadium was the first all seated stadium in Scotland



Aberdeen is one of the sunniest cities in Scotland. The city gets around 1,350 hours of sunshine every year... Not bad for Scotland!



Dolphins love visiting Aberdeen! You can often spot bottlenose dolphins jumping in the harbour near Torry Battery

People in Aberdeen speak a unique dialect called Doric, with fun words like quine (girl) and loon (boy)
